EUPOL COPPS delivers media training to High Judicial Council

EUPOL COPPS' Press Office delivered support in communication and visibility aspects to High Judicial Council (HJC) media department in order to further enhance their media capabilities. The topics evoked were related to website and social network management as well as the use of statistics to further inform the citizens on the HJC activities. The Mission's Press and Public Information Officer delivered the training to the team and additional support is scheduled to be held in the coming months.



EUPOL COPPS Participates in a Summer Camp for the PCP

EUPOL COPPS took part in a summer camp organized by the Palestinian Civil Police. This "Little Policeman" summer camp aimed at raising the kids awareness on traffic safety, drug and tobacco prevention and on the dangers of found objects, fire-arms and fireworks. Some lessons also addressed the dangers of an improper use of the internet, in addition to the lectures presenting the Palestinian Civil Police and its role within the Palestinian society. This summer camp is part of a series of Summer camps taking place in the West Bank.



EUPOL COPPS organises "First Responders" training in Salfit

EUPOL COPPS organised a "First Responders" training in Salfit district. These trainings are designed as scenarios role play covering different situations like crime scene, checkpoints, search and arrest, traffic accident or vehicle search. On each scene, EUPOL COPPS Police Advisors are present in order to give feedback to the Palestinian Civil Police. The scenarios are usually connected to better immerse the participants. Palestinian police operational commander coordinated activities on the ground and about 20 police officers were engaged in this exercise in Salfit.
