EUPOL COPPS participated in a two-day workshop within the framework of the Police Accountability Programme to develop an internal disciplinary system for the Palestinian Civil Police (PCP). The workshop brought together relevant PCP's oversight bodies and other administrations, as well as EUPOL COPPS and United Nations Development Programme advisers to develop the existing PCP rules and regulations.



International Human Rights Day celebrations

EUPOL COPPS joins the UN in its celebration of International Human Rights Day. This year the United Nations and the European Union celebrated this day with a focus on the 50th anniversary of the two Human Rights Covenants on economic, cultural and social rights and on civil and political rights.



Incident reporting software for the

EUPOL COPPS Mission provided the PCP with an incident reporting software to better enhance their capabilities in handling cases related to their work. The PCP carried out a training session to 15 police officers representing various districts in order to explain to them how the new system works.



EUPOL COPPS facilitates study trip to Romania

EUPOL COPPS facilitated a study trip to Romania as part of its support to the Palestinian criminal justice institutions. The main objective of the study visit is to explore existing system of cooperation between the police and prosecution. With this visit, key Palestinian judicial institutions, together with the PCP are encouraged to fight corruption together and to further enhance their mutual cooperation in collecting evidences, reporting corruption crimes and standardizing the procedures between both institutions.

EUPOL COPPS delivered equipment to Palestinian Civil Police. The equipment included 474 high visibility winter jackets, safety vests and stop traffic signs. The aim of these equipment is to further improve the Traffic Police and also to raise public awareness on traffic safety.

EUPOL COPPS Police advisers attended a graduation ceremony for 19 Palestinian Civil Police officers in the Northern West Bank District of Tubas. The police officers were trained while on duty by PCP trainers on a number of topics such as crime scene management, vehicle search, traffic accidents investigation and arrest.
