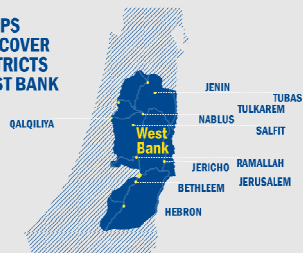

Acting Head of Mission meets Prime Minister Hamdallah

EUPOL COPPS acting Head of Mission (AHoM), Rodolphe Mauget met with the Palestinian Prime Minister Rami Hamdallah. Mr. Mauget expressed his best wishes for the New Year and briefed him on the activities of the Mission in 2014 with Palestinian counterparts. During the meeting, the AHoM discussed with the Palestinian premier EUPOL COPPS' plans for this year to enhance the capabilities of the Palestinian counterparts – the Palestinian Civil Police and the Criminal Justice Institutions as well as the ministries of Interior and Justice.



EUPOL COPPS supports a Human Right training for Palestinian judges and prosecutors

EUPOL COPPS facilitated a training programme on "the Application of Human Rights Law in the Administration of Criminal Justice in Palestine". The training was delivered by senior UK Human Rights Barristers from the Slynn Foundation and funded by the UK Government. It was delivered in two separate sessions to Palestinian Judges and then to members of the Public Prosecution.



EUPOL COPPS supports training for newly appointed Judges

The High Judicial Council and the Palestinian Judicial Institute started an EUPOL COPPS-backed training program to support the newly appointed judges in further enhancing their knowledge to adjudicate criminal cases in a fair and effective way, to deal with public prosecutors and defense during court sessions. The training programme, which consists of 42 days - 21 theoretical and 21 practical - is one of the seven activities supporting the Palestinian Judicial Institute to build capacity by delivering trainings for judges and prosecutors."



EUPOL COPPS's workshop on the protection of domestic violence's of victims

EUPOL COPPS Mission organized a two-day workshop on enhancing mechanisms and procedures to improve the protection of the victims of domestic violence, involving the Palestinian Civil Police (PCP) and the Attorney General Office (AGO). During the two sessions held in the West Bank city of Ramallah, EUPOL COPPS advisers from the Police Advisory Section facilitated discussions among 35 participants coming from the PCP Family and Juveniles Protection Unit (FJPU) and Specialized Prosecution on Domestic and Gender-based Violence, representing all West Bank districts.



EUPOLCOPPS organizes New Year's ceremony for counterparts

EUPOL COPPS Acting Head of Mission Rodolphe Mauget held a reception on the occasion of the New Year's Eve in Ramallah. Palestinian officials and representatives, including Head of the Palestinian Anti-Corruption Commission, the Chief Justice and representatives from the Attorney General Office, along with delegates from many Consulates and senior Palestinian Civil Police officers attended the event. In his speech, Mr. Rodolphe Mauget praised the work that has been accomplished in the past year.
