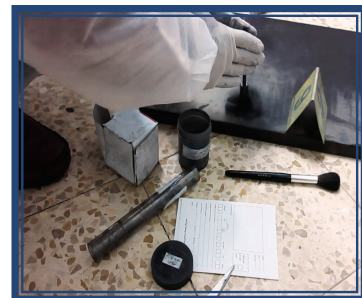


Palestinian Civil Police perform drills on First Responders

The visit, part of a wider program to include all of Palestinian districts, aimed at strengthening the relationship between the PCP's Family Protection Unit and the prosecution on cases of domestic violence. During the meeting, which was attended by a three-member team of EUPOL COPPS, issues pertaining to juveniles and training needs in that area were discussed.

The workshop also aimed at assessing the Palestinian needs on training. The activities that were discussed were based on best European standards.
