

Formation of MOU Implementation Group

The first meeting of the Police-Prosecution Memorandum of Understanding Implementation Group (MIG) took place at the PCP's HQ. This meeting, brokered by EUPOL COPPS' Prosecution Team, laid down the *modus operandi* of the MIG. The MIG will have monthly meetings on regular basis, hosted alternately by the PCP and the Attorney General's Office (AGO).



Study visit to Finland for ACC

Three prosecutors from the Palestinian Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) attended a study trip to Helsinki and Turku (Finland), which was organised and conducted by EUPOL COPPS Prosecution team. The study trip aimed to raise awareness among the ACC prosecutors about how to structure and organise the ACC's duties properly under the Anti-Corruption Law.



TOT refresher course for PCP Commissioners

At the Bethlehem District Commander and Station Commanders' initiative, along with the Central Training Administration (CTA), the PCP organized a *Training of Trainers* (ToT) pilot refresher course for Police officers working at station level. This concept will probably be adopted by other Districts in order to ensure training coherence.



Traffic Police completes course on traffic operations

The PCP Traffic Department completed a 2-week course on operational matters that was implemented by the Mission's traffic advisor and defensive tactics expert, as well by two trainers from the Jericho Police Training School (JPTS).
